

THERMOPLASTIC POLYESTER RESIN

Common features of Crastin[®] thermoplastic polyester resin include mechanical and physical properties such as stiffness and toughness, heat resistance, friction and wear resistance, excellent surface finishes and good colourability. Crastin[®] thermoplastic polyester resin has excellent electrical insulation characteristics and high arc-resistant grades are available. Many flame retardant grades have UL recognition (class V-0). Crastin[®] thermoplastic polyester resin typically has high chemical and heat ageing resistance.

The good melt stability of Crastin[®] thermoplastic polyester resin normally enables the recycling of properly handled production waste.

If recycling is not possible, DuPont recommends, as the preferred option, incineration with energy recovery (-24 kJ/g of base polymer) in appropriately equipped installations. For disposal, local regulations have to be observed.

Crastin[®] thermoplastic polyester resin typically is used in demanding applications in the electronics, electrical, automotive, mechanical engineering, chemical, domestic appliances and sporting goods industry.

Crastin[®] SK609 NC010 is a 50% glass fiber reinforced, lubricated polybutylene terephthalate resin for injection moulding.




Viscosity-shear rate



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
Shearstress-shear rate





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
Stress-strain





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
Secant modulus-strain





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
Stress-strain (isochronous) 23°C




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Creep modulus-time 23°C




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
Creep modulus-time 60°C





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
Stress-strain (isochronous) 90°C
